

HOW TO ENTER:

All contestants must be checked in at the Main Shelter House 30 minutes prior to the start of the contest to receive their number assignments. Each contestant must have a number to appear on stage. We cannot give an exact time of presentation of each group or how long each group will take, as there is no way to determine beforehand the number of children in each group. We cannot wait for latecomers.

Check-in begins at 9AM and contest starts at 10AM.

GENERAL RULES:

1. All ages are determined as of contest date – Saturday, September 11th, 2010. Age Groups include: 0-6 months, 6 – 12 months, 1 year olds, 2 year olds, and 3 year olds.
2. Ages 0-6 and 6-12 months will be judged on personality, appearance, and poise.
3. Girls and boys will compete together in each age group (first 20 participants registered in each age group).
4. The festival reserves the right to see proof of age (birth certificate) upon request.
5. An entry fee must accompany each entry form. No refunds will be given.
6. Every participant will receive a ribbon of participation.
7. Entry forms are available at the Main Shelter House at the Rarden Community Park . The morning of competition at 9:00 am.
8. Pageant attire is not necessary. Makeup is not allowed.
9. Each child will be accompanied on stage by one adult (parent/guardian).
10. This contest is for “fun” only. The children will not represent The Rarden Whitetail Deer Festival at any other functions.
11. Parents/Guardians agree that the judge’s decision is final.
